**THIS LICENSE IS AGREED** the 1<sup>st</sup> day of December 2020

between

1. **KONINKLIJKE BRILL NV**, Plantijnstraat 2, 2300 PA Leiden, The Netherlands ("the Publisher")

and

2. the respective **Participating Organisations set forth in Schedule 1** hereto (hereinafter referred to as "Members of the Consortium") and duly represented by the National Library of Sweden, Box 5039, 102 41 Stockholm, Sweden.

**WHEREAS** the Publisher holds the rights granted under this License

**AND WHEREAS** the Members of the Consortium desires to use these rights and the Publisher desires to grant to the Members of the Consortium the license to use these rights for the Fee, subject to the terms and conditions of this License.

**IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS: -**

### 1. KEY DEFINITIONS

1.1 In this License, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

**Authorized Users** means any of the following persons authorized by the Licensee to access the Licensee's information services via Secure Access:

- i. **Students** means any person undertaking education or research who is currently enrolled as a student only by the Licensee and not by any other institution. Visiting students and researchers are temporarily classed as "Students" whether or not they are registered or enrolled by the Licensee. Students may access the Licensed Materials on-site or off-site.
- ii. **Staff** means any personnel currently used by the Licensee to instruct or direct Students, the Licensee's research staff and administrative and management personnel. Staff may access the Licensed Materials on-site or off-site.
- iii. **Walk-in users** means any person while they are on the premises of the Licensee who use the Licensed Materials for private study or personal interest only.

**Commercial Use** Use for the purposes of monetary reward (whether by or for the Consortium or a Member or an Authorized User) by means of sale, resale, loan, transfer, hire or other form of exploitation of the Licensed Materials. Neither recovery of direct costs by the Consortium or any Member from Authorized Users, nor use by the Consortium or a Member or by an Authorized User of the Licensed Materials in the course of research funded by a commercial organization is deemed to be Commercial Use.

## 2. AGREEMENT

The Publisher agrees to grant to the Consortium the non-exclusive and non-transferable right, throughout the world, to give Members and Authorized Users access to the Licensed Materials via a Secure Network for the purposes of research, teaching and private study, subject to the terms and conditions of this License, and the Consortium agrees to pay the Fee. This License shall commence at the beginning of the Subscription Period for each of the Licensed Materials as set out in Schedule 1 or in new Schedules to this License that may be added subsequently; and shall automatically terminate at the end of the Subscription Period, unless the parties have previously agreed to renew it. New libraries are able to opt in at any moment during the year.

2.1 Renewal may take place by e-mail correspondence between the parties.

### 3. USAGE RIGHTS

- 3.1 The Consortium and or/its Members, subject to clause 6 below, may:
- 3.1.1 Make such temporary local electronic copies by means of caching of all or part of the Licensed Materials as are necessary solely to ensure efficient use by Authorized Users and not to make available to Authorized Users duplicate copies of the Licensed Material.
  - 3.1.2 Allow Authorized Users to have access to the Licensed Materials from the Server via the Secure Network.
  - 3.1.3 Provide Authorized Users with integrated access and an integrated author, article title, abstract and keyword index to the Licensed Material and all other similar material licensed from other publishers.
  - 3.1.4 Provide single printed or electronic copies of single articles at the request of individual Authorized Users.
  - 3.1.5 Display, download or print the Licensed Materials for the purpose of internal marketing or testing or for training Authorized Users or groups of Authorized Users.
- 3.2 Authorized Users may, in accordance with the copyright law of The Netherlands and subject to clause 6 below:
- 3.2.1 Search, view, retrieve and display the Licensed Materials.
  - 3.2.2 Print a copy or download and save Documents for personal use.
  - 3.2.3 Use Documents within Learning Objects for Members' teaching, learning or training purposes.
  - 3.2.4 Use Text and Data Mining technologies to derive information from the Licensed Materials. Authorized Users may use the results of any Text Mining activity for their research, including without limitation the creation of an index, abstract, or description of Licensed Materials, whether in the form of a direct extraction or a representation in any form which is based on subscribed Content. If published, the research must be original and must not amount to a derivative work.
  - 3.2.5 Distribute a copy of Documents in print or electronic form to other Authorized Users or to other individual scholars collaborating with Authorized Users but only for the purposes of research and private study; for the avoidance of doubt, this sub-clause shall include the distribution of a copy for teaching purposes to each individual student Authorized User in a class at the Member's institution.
  - 3.2.6 Download a copy of Documents and share the same with Authorized Users or other individual scholars collaborating in a specific research project with such Authorized Users provided that it is held and accessibly within a closed network that is not accessible to any person not directly involved in such collaboration and provided that it is deleted from such network immediately upon completion of the collaboration.

3.3 Nothing in this License shall in any way exclude, modify or affect any of the Consortium's or any Member's statutory rights under the copyright laws of The Netherlands.

### 4. SUPPLY OF COPIES TO OTHER LIBRARIES

4.1 Members may, subject to clause 6 below, supply to an Authorized User of another library within the same country as the Consortium, whether by post or fax or secure transmission, using Ariel or its equivalent, whereby the electronic file is deleted immediately after printing, for the purposes of research or private study and not for Commercial Use, a single paper copy of an electronic original of a Document.

### 5. COURSE PACKS AND ELECTRONIC RESERVE

5.1 Members may, subject to clause 6 below, incorporate parts of the Licensed Materials in printed Course Packs and Electronic Reserve collections and in Virtual Learning Environments for the use of Authorized Users in the course of instruction at a Member's institution, but not for Commercial Use. Each Document shall carry appropriate acknowledgement of the source, listing title and author of the extract, title and author of the work, and the publisher. Copies of such Documents shall be deleted by the Member when they are no longer used for such purpose. Course packs in non-electronic non-print perceptible form, such as audio or Braille, may also be offered to Authorized Users who are visually impaired.

### 6. PROHIBITED USES

6.1 Neither the Consortium nor any Member nor Authorized Users may:

6.1.1 remove or alter the authors' names or the Publisher's copyright notices or other means of identification or disclaimers as they appear in the Licensed Materials;

6.1.2 systematically make print or electronic copies of multiple extracts or make multiple copies of any part of the Licensed Materials for any purpose other than expressly permitted by this License;

6.1.3 prepare derivative works or download, mount or distribute any part of the Licensed Material on any electronic system or network, including without limitation the Internet and the World Wide Web, other than the Secure Network, except where expressly permitted by this License under clause 3.2.6;

6.1.4 reverse engineer, decompile, alter, abridge or otherwise modify the Licensed Materials or any part of them for any purpose whatsoever, except as expressly provided in this License.

6.2 The Publisher's explicit written permission must be obtained in order to:

6.2.1 use all or any part of the Licensed Materials for any Commercial Use;

6.2.2 systematically distribute the whole or any part of the Licensed Materials to anyone other than Authorized Users;

- 6.2.3 publish, distribute or make available the Licensed Materials, works based on the Licensed Materials or works which combine them with any other material, other than as permitted in this License;
- 6.2.4 alter, abridge, adapt or modify the Licensed Materials, except to the extent necessary to make them perceptible on a computer screen or as otherwise permitted in this License, to Authorized Users. For the avoidance of doubt, no alteration of the words or their order is permitted.

## 7. PUBLISHER'S UNDERTAKINGS

- 7.1 The Publisher warrants to the Consortium that the Licensed Materials used as contemplated by this License do not infringe the copyright or any other proprietary or intellectual property rights of any person. The Publisher shall indemnify and hold the Consortium and its Members harmless from and against any loss, damage, costs, liability and expenses (including reasonable legal and professional fees) arising out of any legal action taken against the Consortium or any of its Members claiming actual or alleged infringement of such rights. This indemnity shall survive the termination of this License for any reason. This indemnity shall not apply if the Consortium or any of its Members has amended the Licensed Materials in any way not permitted by this License.
- 7.2 The Publisher shall:
  - 7.2.1 make the Licensed Materials available to each Member from the Server via the Internet access as specified in **Schedule 1**. The Publisher will notify the Consortium at least sixty (60) days in advance of any anticipated specification change applicable to the Licensed Materials. If the changes render the Licensed Materials less useful in a material respect to the Consortium, the Consortium may within thirty days of such notice treat such changes as a breach of this License under clause 10.1.2 and 10.1.4.
  - 7.2.2 provide each Member, within 30 days of the date of this License, with information sufficient to enable Members to access the Licensed Materials.
  - 7.2.3 use reasonable endeavours to ensure that the Server has adequate capacity and bandwidth to support the usage of the Members at a level commensurate with the standards of availability for information services of similar scope operating via the World Wide Web, as such standards evolve from time to time over the term of this License.
  - 7.2.4 use reasonable endeavours to make the Licensed Materials available to Members at all times and on a twenty-four hour basis, save for routine maintenance (which shall be notified to the Consortium in advance wherever possible), and to restore access to the Licensed Materials as soon as possible in the event of an interruption or suspension of the service.
  - 7.2.5 make the Licensed Materials available to the Licensee and to Authorized Users through IP authentication at all times and on a twenty-four hour basis, save for routine maintenance (which shall be notified to the Licensee in advance wherever possible), and to restore access to the Licensed Materials as soon as possible in the event of an interruption or suspension of the service. In case of prolonged and/or repeated interruption or suspension, Licensee shall be entitled to claim fair damages and/or compensation from Publisher.

- 7.2.6 use reasonable endeavours to make available the electronic copy of each journal issue in the Licensed Materials not later than the day of publication of the printed version if a printed version exists. In the event that for technical reasons this is not possible for any particular journal, as a matter of course, such journal shall be identified at the time of licensing, together with such reasons.
- 7.2.7 use reasonable endeavours to ensure that the Server has adequate capacity and bandwidth to support the usage of the Licensee at a level commensurate with the standards of availability for information services of similar scope operating via the World Wide Web, as such standards evolve from time to time over the term of this License.
- 7.2.8 The Publisher undertakes to provide or to make arrangements for a third party to provide an archive of the Licensed Materials for the purposes of long term preservation, and to permit Authorized Users to access such archive after termination of this License.
- 7.2.9 Upon Licensee's request, the Publisher shall provide to the Licensee or facilitate the collection and provision to the Licensee of COUNTER compliant usage statistics (<http://www.projectcounter.org>) on the number of titles, abstracts and articles downloaded or printed, by journal title, on a monthly basis. Such usage data shall be compiled in a manner consistent with applicable privacy and data protection laws, and the anonymity of individual users and the confidentiality of their searches shall be fully protected. In the case that the Publisher assigns its rights to another party under clause 11.3, the Licensee may at its discretion require the assignee either to keep such usage information confidential or to destroy it. The Publisher will also use reasonable endeavours to implement the Standardized Usage Statistics Harvesting Initiative (SUSHI) protocol (<http://www.niso.org/workrooms/sushi>).
- 7.2.10 The Publisher will provide Licensee with detailed lists of all journals included in the Licensed Materials of the following year each 15th of September of the Subscription Period. Such lists shall be delivered in MS Excel format and shall include: title, print ISSN and online ISSN, URL, access start year, volume, issue, as well as a clear indication of the Open Access journals.
- 7.2.11 In order to ensure accurate, up to date representation of the Licensed Materials and to ensure that Licensee and its Authorized Users have ease of access and use, the Publisher will:
- 7.2.12 provide link-resolver vendors and other library systems suppliers quarterly with full details of the Licensed Materials in accordance with the most current KBART standard (<http://www.uksg.org/kbart/s5/guidelines>); and also with related data of (i) the first and final year, volume, and issue and (ii) the algorithm or syntax for constructing an article-level link from an article's metadata within the Licensed Materials;
- 7.2.13 use all reasonable efforts to meet the W3C standards ([www.w3.org/WAI/Resources/#in](http://www.w3.org/WAI/Resources/#in)), the Open URL Standard (ANSI/NISO Z39.88) and the NISO recommended practice Access and License Indicators (NISO RP-22-2015 - <http://www.niso.org/workrooms/ali/>);
- 7.2.14 use all reasonable efforts to keep to the Code of Practice of Project Transfer ([www.projecttransfer.org](http://www.projecttransfer.org)) to ensure that journal content remains easily accessible by the Licensee and its Authorized Users when there is a transfer of material between parties, and to ensure that the transfer process occurs with minimum disruption;
- 7.2.15 use all reasonable efforts to deliver, upon request, metadata and full text relating to the Licensed Materials to the National Library of Sweden and Licensee by FTP data feed or by



any other means agreed between the parties. The metadata will contain the following fields: chapter/article title, book/journal title, ISBN/ISSN, author(s), volume, issue, year, page, publisher and link to full text on the online-platform. The National Library of Sweden may load and format the metadata onto the freely accessible National Union Catalogue Libris (<http://libris.kb.se>). The Licensee may load and format the metadata onto the Licensee's server to enable indexing of the Licensed Materials by the Licensee solely for the purpose of enhanced navigation. The Licensee may load the metadata to a secure third party server provided that the Licensee is contractually responsible for the third party. Access to the full text will solely be available to Authorised Users on Secure Networks. The Publisher agrees to permit the National Library of Sweden and the Licensee to release metadata relating to the Licensed Materials using a Creative Commons License CC0 (<http://creativecommons.org/about/cc0>).

- 7.3 Where the Licensed Materials shall not be available to Members for more than thirty (30) consecutive days, the Publisher shall refund to the Consortium or the Members a proportion of the Fee prorated to the period of such unavailability within the Subscription Period to which the Fee relates.
- 7.4 The Publisher reserves the right at any time to withdraw from the Licensed Materials any item or part of an item for which it no longer retains the right to publish, or which it has reasonable grounds to believe infringes copyright or is defamatory, obscene, unlawful or otherwise objectionable. The Publisher shall give written notice to the Consortium of such withdrawal. If the withdrawal represents more than ten per cent (10%) of the Licensed Materials, the Publisher shall refund to the Consortium or its Members that part of the Fee that is in proportion to the amount of material withdrawn and the remaining un-expired portion of the Subscription Period.
- 7.5 The Publisher has arrangements with a third party to provide an archive of the Licensed Materials for the purposes of long term preservation of the Licensed Materials. The archived Licensed Materials will become available to Licensee in the following circumstances:
- If the Publisher applies for an adjudication in bankruptcy ("faillissement") or a suspension of payments ("surseance van betaling"); if the Publisher is declared bankrupt or granted a suspension of payments; if an attachment ("beslag") is made on the Publisher's assets.
- 7.6 Collection and analysis of data on the usage of the Licensed Materials will assist both the Publisher and the Consortium and/or its Members to understand the impact of this License. The Publisher shall facilitate the collection and provision of usage data on the number of Documents downloaded, by supplying tools to the Consortium and/or the Members to generate statistics on a monthly basis for the Consortium's and Members' private internal use only. Such usage data shall be compiled in a manner consistent with applicable privacy and data protection laws and as may be agreed between the parties from time to time, and the anonymity of individual users and the confidentiality of their searches shall be fully protected. The Publisher undertakes to provide these usage data in a manner compliant to COUNTER directives. In the case that the Publisher assigns its rights to another party under clause 11.3, the Consortium and/or the Member may at its discretion require the assignee either to keep such usage information confidential or to destroy it.
- 7.7 EXCEPT AS EXPRESSLY PROVIDED IN THIS LICENSE, THE PUBLISHER MAKES NO REPRESENTATIONS OR WARRANTIES OF ANY KIND, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, WARRANTIES OF DESIGN, ACCURACY OF THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE





LICENSED MATERIALS, MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS OF USE FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. THE LICENSED MATERIALS ARE SUPPLIED 'AS IS'.

- 7.8 EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN CLAUSE 7.1, UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHALL THE PUBLISHER BE LIABLE TO THE CONSORTIUM OR ANY OF ITS MEMBERS OR ANY OTHER PERSON, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO AUTHORIZED USERS, FOR ANY SPECIAL, EXEMPLARY, INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OF ANY CHARACTER ARISING OUT OF THE INABILITY TO USE, OR THE USE OF, THE LICENSED MATERIALS. IRRESPECTIVE OF THE CAUSE OR FORM OF ACTION, THE PUBLISHER'S AGGREGATE LIABILITY FOR ANY CLAIMS, LOSSES, OR DAMAGES ARISING OUT OF ANY BREACH OF THIS LICENSE SHALL IN NO CIRCUMSTANCES EXCEED THE FEE PAID BY CONSORTIUM TO THE PUBLISHER UNDER THIS LICENSE IN RESPECT OF THE SUBSCRIPTION PERIOD DURING WHICH SUCH CLAIM, LOSS OR DAMAGE OCCURRED. THE FOREGOING LIMITATION OF LIABILITY AND EXCLUSION OF CERTAIN DAMAGES SHALL APPLY REGARDLESS OF THE SUCCESS OR EFFECTIVENESS OF OTHER REMEDIES. REGARDLESS OF THE CAUSE OR FORM OF ACTION, THE CONSORTIUM MAY BRING NO ACTION ARISING FROM THIS LICENSE MORE THAN SIX (6) MONTHS AFTER THE CAUSE OF ACTION ARISES.

## 8. CONSORTIUM'S UNDERTAKINGS

- 8.1 The Consortium or each Member shall:

- 8.1.1 use reasonable endeavours to ensure that all Authorized Users are aware of the importance of respecting the intellectual property rights in the Licensed Materials and of the terms and conditions of this License, and use reasonable endeavours to notify Authorized Users of the terms and conditions of this License and take steps to protect the Licensed Materials from unauthorized use or other breach of this License;
- 8.1.2 use reasonable endeavours to monitor compliance and immediately upon becoming aware of any unauthorized use or other breach, inform the Publisher and take all reasonable and appropriate steps, including disciplinary action, both to ensure that such activity ceases and to prevent any recurrence;
- 8.1.3 issue passwords or other access information only to Authorized Users, refrain from posting details of the user id and password on the institution's intranet or on the internet, and use all reasonable endeavours to ensure that Authorized Users do not divulge their passwords or other access information to any third party;
- 8.1.4 provide the Publisher, within 30 days of the date of this Agreement, with information sufficient to enable the Publisher to provide access to the Licensed Material in accordance with its obligation under clause 7.2.3. Should the Consortium make any significant change to such information, it will notify the Publisher not less than ten (10) days before the change takes effect.
- 8.1.5 keep full and up-to-date records of all IP addresses and provide the Publisher with details of such additions, deletions or other alterations to such records as are necessary to enable the Publisher to provide Authorized Users with access to the Licensed Materials as contemplated by this License.

- 8.2 THE CONSORTIUM AGREES TO INDEMNIFY, DEFEND AND HOLD THE PUBLISHER HARMLESS FROM AND AGAINST ANY LOSS, DAMAGE, COSTS, LIABILITY AND EXPENSES (INCLUDING REASONABLE LEGAL AND PROFESSIONAL FEES) ARISING OUT OF ANY CLAIM OR LEGAL ACTION TAKEN



AGAINST THE PUBLISHER RELATED TO OR IN ANY WAY CONNECTED WITH ANY USE OF THE LICENSED MATERIALS BY THE CONSORTIUM, MEMBERS OR AUTHORIZED USERS OR ANY FAILURE BY THE CONSORTIUM TO PERFORM ITS OBLIGATIONS IN RELATION TO THIS LICENSE, PROVIDED THAT NOTHING IN THIS LICENSE SHALL MAKE THE CONSORTIUM OR ANY MEMBER LIABLE FOR BREACH OF THE TERMS OF THE LICENSE BY ANY AUTHORIZED USER PROVIDED THAT THE CONSORTIUM AND THE MEMBER DID NOT CAUSE, KNOWINGLY ASSIST OR CONDONE THE CONTINUATION OF SUCH BREACH TO CONTINUE AFTER BECOMING AWARE OF AN ACTUAL BREACH HAVING OCCURRED.

- 8.3 The National Library of Sweden shall, in consideration for the rights granted under this License, pay the Fee within sixty (60) days of reception of invoice relating to each subscription year. The invoice shall be sent and dated within the first week of January of the subscription year. For the avoidance of doubt, the Fee shall be exclusive of any sales, use, value added or similar taxes and the Licensees shall be liable for any such taxes in addition to the Fee. The Publisher will invoice the National Library of Sweden for the Fee payable at: Kungliga biblioteket - National Library of Sweden, National Co-operation Department, Box 5039 SE-102 41 Stockholm, Sweden.

## 9. UNDERTAKINGS BY BOTH PARTIES

- 9.1 Each party shall use its best endeavours to safeguard the intellectual property, confidential information and proprietary rights of the other party.

## 10. TERM AND TERMINATION

The Agreement starts on 1 January 2021 and is valid until the 31<sup>st</sup> December 2023. In addition to automatic termination (unless renewed) under clause 2.2, this License shall be terminated:

- 10.1.1 if the Consortium or its Members default in making payment of the Fee as provided in this License and fail to remedy such default within thirty (30) days of notification in writing by the Publisher;
- 10.1.2 if the Publisher commits a material or persistent breach of any term of this License and fails to remedy the breach (if capable of remedy) within thirty (30) days of notification in writing by the Consortium;
- 10.1.3 if the Consortium or any Member commits a wilful material and persistent breach of the Publisher's copyright or other intellectual property rights or of the provisions of clause 3 in respect of usage rights or of clause 6 in respect of prohibited uses;
- 10.1.4 if either party becomes insolvent or becomes subject to receivership, liquidation or similar external administration.
- 10.1.5 Participating Libraries are allowed to opt out during the term of this Agreement by giving the Publisher notice in writing no later than the 30th day of November in the year preceding the subscription year the library wishes to opt out of. Termination of access to the offer of uncapped publishing and access to the licensed materials shall take effect as of the 1st day of the calendar year. Participating Libraries which opt out after a calendar year begins will not receive a partial or full refund of the subscription fee. If a library opts out one year and then decides to rejoin the consortium in a subsequent year, they will not be entitled to the

new member price, but will pay the applicable fee for their institution according to this agreement. New libraries are able to opt in at any moment during the year.

- 10.2 On termination all rights and obligations of the parties automatically terminate.
- 10.3 On termination of this License for cause, as specified in clauses 10.1.1 and 10.1.3, the Consortium and/or its Members shall immediately cease to distribute or make available the Licensed Materials to Authorized Users and shall return to the Publisher or destroy all Licensed Materials locally mounted pursuant to clause 3.1.1 and 3.1.2.
- 10.4 On termination of this License by the Consortium for cause, as specified in clause 10.1.2 above, the Publisher shall forthwith refund the proportion of the Fee that represents the paid but un-expired part of the Subscription Period.

## 11 TERMS OF OPEN ACCESS PUBLICATION

The Publisher grants to eligible authors at participating institutions the right to uncapped publishing of research articles in the Publisher's journal titles for the period of the agreement. All publishing fees for the period of the agreement are included in the fees stated in Schedule 1.

### 11.1 Identification of Eligible Authors

Publisher shall be responsible for the identification of Eligible Authors as part of the submission and publication process. Eligible Authors shall be identified through at least one of the following parameters: their institution name; their e-mail domain; persistent identifier, such as Ringgold, ORCID or other recognized institutional identifier; and/or by IP range recognition.

Eligible Authors shall not be offered the option to publish their Eligible Article under any license other than the Open Access License. Nothing in this Agreement shall be taken to restrict, limit or curtail any provisions of the Open Access License.

- Publisher will strive to clearly indicate the availability of an institutional funding agreement to Eligible Authors both within the submission process and on its website. It will make clear that Eligible Authors do not need to pay article processing charges for publishing articles open access.
- If Publisher fails to identify authors as Eligible Authors and then publishes their article under a subscription model, Publisher shall be responsible to convert the article promptly so that it is published pursuant to the Open Access License. In such case, no APC token will be deducted.
- If Publisher fails to identify authors as Eligible Authors and then charges them with article processing charges for publication of their article, Publisher shall refund such paid APC to the author within 30 days.

### 11.3 Article Publication

- Eligible Articles are published online without delay and in the first instance under the Open Access License, with Eligible Authors retaining their copyrights. Eligible Authors only grant Publisher the non-exclusive right to publish Eligible Articles under the terms and conditions of the Open Access License.
- Affiliation of the Eligible Authors, funders of the research and funder of the open access publication must be stated in the version of record of the articles.
- Upon publication, Publisher will provide the Eligible Author by email with a PDF copy of the version of record of the Eligible Article, the article's DOI, the funder name, and a human-readable summary of



the Open Access License terms with encouragements to share the article in compliance to it, for example via social medias, blogs and repositories.

Publisher will also submit the article and its metadata to all relevant third-party repositories.

- Publisher will make all published Eligible Articles available to anyone on its website at all times, including beyond the Term, and on a twenty-four hour basis, save for routine maintenance (which shall be notified in advance wherever possible). Publisher will restore access as soon as possible in the event of an interruption or suspension of the service. In case of prolonged and/or repeated interruption or suspension, the Member shall be entitled to claim fair damages and/or compensation from Publisher.
- Publisher ensures that its server has adequate capacity and bandwidth to support access to published Eligible Articles at a level commensurate with the standards of availability for information services of similar scope operating via the World Wide Web, as such standards evolve from time to time.
- No additional service fees (e.g. colour-in-print, reprints, posters) will be charged under this Agreement. Any additional service fees will be at the discretion of, and for payment by the Eligible Authors.

#### 11.5 Metadata and Industry Standards

When provided by the Eligible Author, Publisher undertakes to use ORCID (<http://orcid.org/>) throughout the workflow from submission to publication and expose Eligible Authors' ORCID ID in Eligible Articles and via Abstracting & Indexing (A&I) services, CrossRef and other discovery services.

- o Upon publication of an Eligible Article, Publisher will register as much metadata as possible on CrossRef, including, but not limited to: (1) the Eligible Article's digital object identifier (DOI), (2) the funding metadata, including funder name and grant number, in the metadata in Funder Registry (on CrossRef), (3) bibliographic citations, (4) funder of the open access publication and (5) the Open Access License.
- o Publisher is responsible for updated and clear information at the DOAJ and SHERPA/RoMEO websites.
- o Publisher will comply with the last version of NISO's Recommended Practice on Access and Licensing Indicators (<https://www.niso.org/standards-committees/access-and-license-indicators>), including, but not limited to, guidance regarding `free_to_read` and `license_reference` metadata fields and regarding mechanisms for distributing metadata.

#### 11.6 Editorial Independence

- The parties acknowledges that while the Member has financial obligations towards Publisher, the Member is in no way involved with the editorial process. Nothing herein contained shall oblige Publisher to publish any article submitted to Publisher by an Eligible Author. Member acknowledges that the selection of material to be published by Publisher is entirely at the discretion of Publisher's editorial policy.

#### 11.7 Reporting

The Publisher will submit monthly reports to the Licensee in the first week of each new month.

- 11.2 Alterations to this License and to the Schedules to this License are only valid if they are recorded in writing and signed by both parties.
- 11.3 This License may not be assigned by either party to any other person or organisation, nor may either party sub-contract any of its obligations, except as provided in this License in respect of the management and operation of the Server, without the prior written consent of the other party, which consent shall not unreasonably be withheld.
- 11.4 If rights in all or any part of the Licensed Materials are assigned to another publisher, the Publisher shall use its best endeavours to ensure that the terms and conditions of this License are maintained.
- 11.5 Any notices to be served on either of the parties by the other shall be sent by prepaid recorded delivery or registered post to the address of the addressee as set out in this License or to such other address as notified by either party to the other as its address for service of notices. All such notices shall be deemed to have been received within 14 days of posting.
- 11.6 Neither party’s delay or failure to perform any provision of this License, as result of circumstances beyond its control (including, without limitation, war, strikes, floods, governmental restrictions, power, telecommunications or Internet failures, or damage to or destruction of any network facilities) shall be deemed to be, or to give rise to, a breach of this License.
- 11.7 The invalidity or un-enforceability of any provision of this License shall not affect the continuation or enforceability of the remainder of this License.
- 11.8 Either party’s waiver, or failure to require performance by the other, of any provision of this License will not affect its full right to require such performance at any subsequent time, or be taken or held to be a waiver of the provision itself.
